

★ HOW TO SUCCEED IN JUNIOR HIGH

TEACHERS... GET TO KNOW THEM!

Talk with your teachers about your assignments. Tell your parents the names of your teachers and talk to your parents often about what you are learning in your classes. If you are having difficulty in a subject, ask your teacher for help. They are very willing to help any student who asks.

STUDY AREA... CREATE YOUR OWN

1. Find a quiet place to study.
2. Study at a table or desk with a chair and proper lighting.
3. Collect the following study materials and keep them in your study area:
 - a. Pens, pencils, highlighters, erasers
 - b. Paper, note cards
 - c. Scissors, tape, stapler, ruler, paper clips
 - d. Dictionary
4. Review class notes every night (even if you do not have homework.)
5. Keep class materials organized.

CLASS MATERIALS... BE PREPARED

Pencil & Pen
Assignment Book
Notebook for class, not just a piece of paper
Tablet
Homework
Special equipment for class

RULES... KNOW THEM!

Read your STUDENT HANDBOOK! Act responsible during school hours and while attending school activities. Bring clothes to change for gym class. Do not give your locker combination to anyone!
Ask when you do not understand something.

TAKE TIME EACH DAY TO SHARE YOUR THOUGHTS AND DAYS EVENTS WITH YOUR PARENTS!

STAY INFORMED! TAKE CHARGE!

Ask if you do not understand.
Make informed choices.
Complete your work on time.

SCHOOL ACTIVITIES... PARTICIPATE!

Get involved in a sport or music activity.
Join a school club.
Run for student council.
Attend the After School Program.
Participate in school activities.

COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES... STAY INVOLVED

If you belong to scouts, 4-H, or youth group, stay involved with the activity.
Continue to take dance and music lessons.
Stay involved with activities that you enjoy.
